The 1996 Summer BBQ Picnic Event

As promised by the QESOSA (Ontario), we are going to host a BBQ picnic in July. The location will be the gorgeous provincial park at Sibbald Point. The park is located on the southern shore of Lake Simcoe, just East of the town of Sutton. It processes a beautiful two kilometers long sandy beach and a huge playing area. Other activities include a hiking trail, boat rental, museum, bird watching and fishing. However, there will be no life guard service along the beach.

Here are the driving directions to the park and you can find three detailed maps on the next page. The route will start at Markham road and Steeles Ave in Scarborough. You should go north on Markham road (Hwy. 48) for about 32 kms. Along the way, you will drive pass Hwy. 7, Town of Markham, Hwy. 47, Davis Drive, Town of Mount Albert, Town of Baldwin and Town of Sutton. At town of Sutton, Hwy. 48 will make a 90 degree curve and bent toward the direction of "EAST". Just after the bent, you will see the Briars Inn on your left. Pay attention now! You need to make a left turn on Park Road at the first traffic light. Drive along Park road for about one kilometer and the entrance to Sibbald Point will be on you right. After entering the park, you should drive along the main road to the end which is a parking lot. Our picnic area is located at Pavilion #5 just north of the parking area along the lake shore.

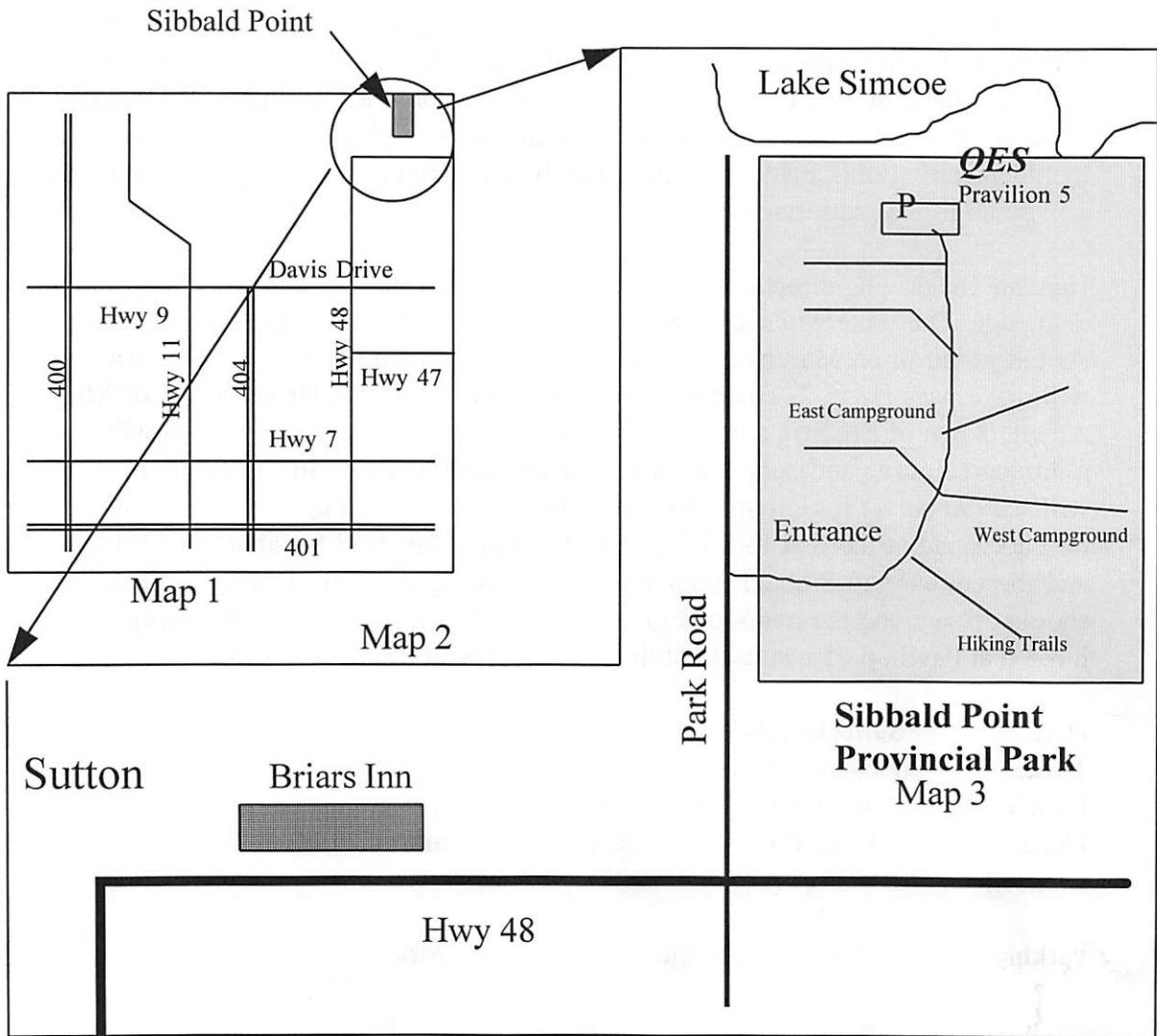

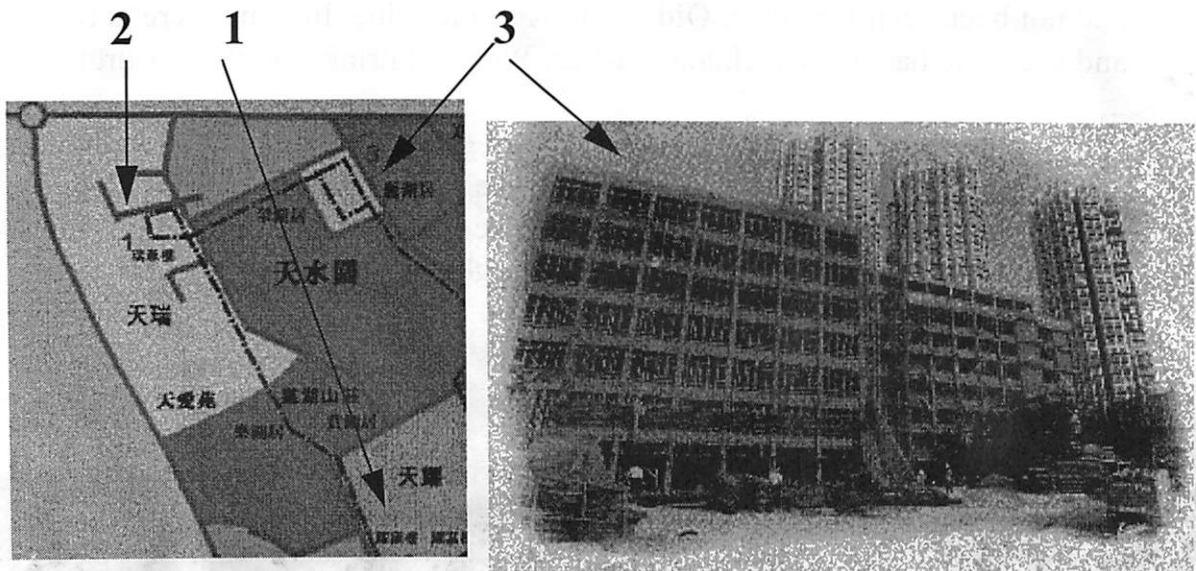
