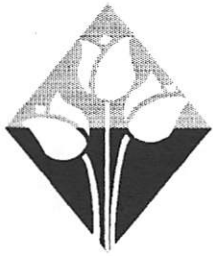

In loving memory of Mr. Wai Fung Cheung, a true educator 永遠懷念您, 張維豐校長

Mr. Wai Fung Cheung, the founding principal of QES, passed away on March 10, 1998, at the age of 94. Mr. Cheung came from a Christian family in the Province of Guangdong. He received his early school education in China and then went on for his secondary education in Hong Kong, studying at St. Joseph College and Queen's College. He entered the University of Hong Kong in 1921 and obtained his B.A. degree in 1925, majoring in Education. Following his graduation, Mr. Cheung started his long and distinguished teaching career at Queen's College. During the War, Mr. Cheung went back to China to teach English and returned to Hong Kong after the War. He then held various important positions in the Education Department, and in 1954, became the founding principal of QES. He held the post until his retirement in 1959.

To most of his students, Mr. Cheung always appeared serious and awe-inspiring. However, behind the solemnity was a very kind heart that always put the students' well-being in top priority. His devotion to QES and his determination to make QES a first-rate school inspired all and commanded deep respect from his students. Because of Mr. Cheung, QES had a great start. Through his efforts and also those of his successors, QES became one of the best schools in Hong Kong. His dedication to education will serve as a role model for many and will be dearly remembered by us for years to come.

The Background:

QESOSA (Ontario) was formally established a few months after our Principal from 59-67, Mr. Arthur Hinton's Ontario visit in June, 1989. The association has been considerably active by networking between members as well as keeping close contact with our mother and brother/sister associations.

In 1991, our members responded favourably to the plead by QESOSA (HK) to support the rebuilding of the school camp at Sai Kung.

The Origin:

In 1993, to demonstrate QESOSA(Ontario)'s support to the inauguration of QESOSA schools, we have committed to two book awards. One award each for the most deserving student from the graduating classes of the AM and PM primary schools. The selection criteria should base on financial need and academic merits. This was later known as the QESOSA(Ontario) Scholarship Fund.

The Achievement:

The QESOSA(Ontario) has been graciously acknowledged in the year book of the schools. Despite our physical distance from the QESOSA schools, our members, through the years, have shown extreme generosity towards this worthy cause.

Our Support from USA:

Early this year the editor received a generous donation for the scholarship fund from Oakland, California. On reading through our QESOSA(Ontario) newsletter of October 97, Kathleen Lau(58, 59?), a former Torontonian, sent us her ardent support and generous donation.

Accounting:

All donations are to be put aside as the scholarship fund, separate from the association's operating fund. The QESOSA(Ontario) Board of Directors are to act as the executor of the scholarship fund.

All funds received should be for the sole purpose of contribution to the QESOSA schools as scholarships or awards only.

Looking to the Future:

QESOSA (Ontario) would like to challenge other brother/sister organizations – QESOSA(BC) and QESOSA(Australia), etc. to do the same and demonstrate the true QES. spirit.

The Plan:

For all the activities planned this year, the Board will direct all members (and friends and families, of course) to the association's 1998 objective -- *Our Contribution and Support to the Scholarship Fund*. We will try to create innovative ways to motivate members to donate to this most worthwhile cause. Come to the Spring Buffet Luncheon and experience it yourself.

For those who cannot attend our functions, we welcome direct donations towards the scholarship fund. You can make you contribution by cheque or cash. You can even pledge over a certain period of time. Pledges are very simple. All you need to do is to forward your post-dated cheques to the association.

Imagine, pledge \$5 per week for the next twelve months means you give up your one cup of coffee a day.
